Owner is Lake Don Pedro Community Services District (LDPCSD). Statement of Qualifications are due on or before 3:30 P.M., Friday, February 24, 2023, at the Black Water Consulting Engineers Office, 602 Lyell Drive, Modesto, CA 95356. The Lake Don Pedro Community Services District (District) is requesting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from Design-Build Entities (DB Entities) for fixed price design-build services to replace the existing Raw Water Intake & Pump Station system on Lake McClure. The general scope of this project includes the design and construction necessary for the replacement of the Raw Water Intake & Pump Station. The project would remove, replace, and upgrade the existing pump station components, including the existing dual 12-inch diameter pipelines (420 linear feet each), existing pump facilities, check and gate valves, pipe fittings, and electrical controls for the system. Additionally, two high-strength, low-alloy steel pipes, 12-inches in diameter, approximately 415 linear feet each, would be installed, extending into the lake to a depth of 580 feet MSL. The work to be performed under the negotiated Design-Build Contract with the selected Design-Build Entity consists of the engineering, design and preparation of the construction documents, as well as furnishing all labor, materials and equipment for the construction of the project. The Contractor shall hold an active Class A contractor's license in the State of California.

A non-mandatory site meeting will be held at the Lake Don Pedro Community Services District Office, located at 9751 Merced Falls Ed., La Grange, CA 95329, on Thursday, February 2, 2023, at 10:00 A.M. It is the responsibility of the Design-Build Entity to check the website for any addendum to the project. Funding has been provided in full or in part through an agreement with the Department of Water Resources, Small Community Drinking Water Relief Program. The project is subject to prevailing wage and compliance with 40 CFR Section 33.302 Disadvantaged Business Enterprises and USEPA's Program for Utilization of Small, Minority, and Women's Businesses Enterprises rule.
