The Lake Don Pedro Community Services District has an immediate opening for the position of Operations Manager. The District operates a surface water treatment plant and groundwater wells, and provides domestic water services to a population of approximately 3500 in a rural residential community between Lake Don Pedro and Lake McClure in the central Sierra Nevada foothills.

Under the administrative direction of the General Manager, this position plans, organizes and directs the operation, maintenance, quality control, and modification and improvements of the District's water facilities. The Operations Manager joins a professional, efficient and stable management staff and will lead the daily activities of two O&M employees. It is expected that the role will split time between office and field work in a fast-paced environment and the selected candidate must have the ability to adapt to changing priorities. The ideal candidate will be a flexible, resourceful leader with significant accomplishments in maintenance plan implementation and experience as a department manager or supervisor, who possesses solid interpersonal and communication skills.

Qualifications include supervisory or management experience in the operations and maintenance of water treatment, production and distribution systems. A minimum of five years of experience in the operation and maintenance of potable water facilities is highly desirable; a minimum of two in a supervisory capacity. A valid California Class C driver's license must be maintained at all times. Candidates **must** have possession of a Grade II Water Treatment Plant Operator and a Grade II Water Distribution Certificates issued by the State of California, and the ability to obtain Grade III certificates within one year of hire.
